What is the University of Florida's acceptance rate transfer? In 2019, Florida University received 5,983 transfer applicants. The school accepted 2813 students. Therefore, the transfer acceptance rate for the University of Florida is 47.02%. That suggests how difficult it is to transfer to the University of Florida. You can use the free calculator below to predict your chances of getting accepted. In addition, of the 2813 accepted transfer students, 2171 students enrolled - that is, the yield was 77.18%. It's important to note that students will be charged double the tuition for each credit hour above 132 (for students in a 120-hour degree program) or 110 percent above the required hours. Students who have tried 180 credit hours are no longer eligible for financial aid as a college student (including federal student loans). Applicants are required to successfully complete at least 67 percent of all credit hours attempted by current and previously enrolled institutions. A minimum portable GPA of 2.30 is required (except for applicants with an AA degree from the Florida College System institution and a minimum portable GPA of 2.00). Academic credential requirements of usf requires you to submit official transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended. However, we require that all transcripts not originally provided in English be accompanied by a literal English translation. Please note that USF does not guarantee that any course attempted at the post-secondary level will be transferable. The transferability of exchange rates is determined by the exchange rate. Secondary credentials (only required for lower level transfer applicants) USF requires you to submit relevant documents that are equivalent to graduation from a U.S. high school. As a general rule, completion of secondary education will consist of 12 to 13 years of study and the award of a diploma or a baccalaureate certificate. Provide academic transcripts and test results for all secondary school work. If you have obtained an IB diploma or certificate, you will need to submit an official transcript of the international baccalaureate examination directly from the International Baccalaureate Organisation. The SAT/ACT Requirements USF requires lower-level transfer applicants to submit official results of at least one entrance exam to college (SAT or ACT), including essays. Sat Subject Tests are not considered acceptance or placement. The USF code for the SAT is 5828 and the act is 0761. Superscoring USF considers your highest submitted score section in all SAT and ACT trial dates. Final decision-making decisions will only be made using your highest cumulative score. Every time you submit a USF test score, we will update your listing with new high scores. We strongly recommend that you submit your score every time you have a SAT or ACT. Submitting a score every time you have a SAT or ACT can be beneficial to you by allowing us to consider you for all available regiou related options. Concordance and redesigned SAT Redesigned SAT was launched by the College Board in March 2016. USF will adopt the original (before March 2016) SAT also redesigned (March 2016 and later) SAT for adoption in spring 2017 and beyond. For entry and scholarship purposes we will concord any original SAT score on the redesigned SAT scale; we will also superscore all sat messages. If you have taken the original SAT and want to understand how your score will match the new scale, please refer to SAT Score Converter. English proficiency requirements International applicants from non-English speaking countries must provide a minimum IELTS score of 6,5 received within 2 years of the required entry period; TOEFL score 79 (internet test) or 550 (written test) or PTEA score 53. If you come from one of the English-speaking countries listed below, you are not required to submit a TOEFL, IELTS or PTEA score. NOTE: Successful completion with a Class C or higher in the equivalents of ENC 1101 Freshman Composition Skills I, as stated by the Florida Department of Education's nationwide numbering system course, U.S. regionally accredited institutions can be used to dispense with TOEFL/IELTS/PTEA requirements. These course equivalences are at the discretion of the University of South Florida. Applicants who are unable to meet this requirement should contact INTO University of South Florida for information about their academic English program for international students. INTO the University of South Florida also offers bachelor's travel programs for international applicants.
